Location

Accommodation & Food

About the Accommodation

Your accommodation in Sigiriya would be an open space accommodation with wooden beds. The accommodation is surrounded by an organic farm and sometimes you will also be able to see a few wild elephants who visit the garden unexpectedly. There is also a tree hut if you would like to climb up so that you can see the beautiful surroundings of the village. If you are afraid of sleeping in the open space, we do have a room only for girls inside the accommodation. Around 25 participants can stay at the open space accommodation at a time. Since the weather in that area is hot most of the time, the hot water facility will not be available at the accommodation. The accommodation is built in a way where you can get fresh air throughout the day and night. Four bathrooms are also built at the accommodation which will have to be shared among the participants.

Food Arrangements

You will be provided with three meals a day on weekdays and two meals per day on weekends. The meals are a mix of Western and Sri Lankan food, consisting mainly of vegetarian dishes including rice and vegetables.

Facilities

An ATM and a supermarket are located approx. a 20 minutes walk away from your accommodation.

Activities & Events

No scheduled activities outside the program.

Sights & Surroundings

Sigirya Rock Castle should be a must visit destination if you select this program. This is an ancient castle built on the top of giant rock and when you reach the top of the rock, the view would be spectacular. This place also boasts about some important wall paintings and ruins with archeological significance.

Dambulla cave temple is another place you can visit during your stay in Sigiriya. This Buddhist temple is also a popular destination among tourists due to the presence of around 80 caves in the area.
